Long time CLTm member Michelle Damme passed away on May 29, 2006. Please keep her family in your thoughts and prayers.

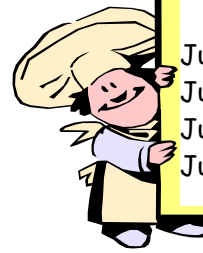
Phoenix Leadership Team in Nevada
